Line 598 \$session\_obj =& singleton::getInstance('php\_session'); is simply instantiating an object from the php\_session class, so \$\_SESSION will remain empty until the following call to session\_start().

What is the value in \$session\_name?

What is the value in \$\_GET['session\_id']?

These two values should point to an existing session\_id. Is it the correct id? Does that session data still exist? If your session handler is the database (which it should be by default) then look in the php\_session table of the AUDIT database.
