The only entry you need in an htaccess file is the location of the 'includes' directory, as this may be outside the web root.

If you are running 'radicore/menu/logon.php' then it should be able to find the file 'php\_session.class.inc' in 'radicore/audit/classes/php\_session.class.inc'.

Your include\_path has a reference to '../audit', so it should be able to find what it's looking for. If it cannot then either it is looking in the wrong place, in which case you need to double check that you have followed the installation instructions to the letter, or you have something peculiar with your PHP installation, such as an incorrect safe\_mode setting.
