I've managed to change the pgsql class to convert the arguments in the DATE\_SUB() function into the correct types, as follows:

WHERE DATE\_SUB(due\_date::timestamp, visibility \* '1 day'::interval) <= '2011-12-14'

I've also had to change the where2indexedArray() function in the library to accept '::' in column names.

The two changed files are in the attached update. See if this fixes your problem.
