I am a PHP newbie and have just installed radicore on my local Win XP/Apache/PHP 5/Postgre system.

When I attempt to login I get the following error:

I suspect that I have not edited the config.inc file correctly. Here are some relevant config.inc file lines:

\$GLOBALS['dbms'] = 'pgsql'; // database engine is PostgreSQL \$GLOBALS['dbhost'] = 'localhost'; \$GLOBALS['PGSQL_dbname'] = 'radicore'; if (eregi('^(localhost|desktop|laptop)\$', \$_SERVER['localhost'])) { // this is for my PC \$GLOBALS['dbusername'] = 'harris'; \$GLOBALS['dbuserpass'] = 'grAce'; \$GLOBALS['dbprefix'] = null;

I do not have a 'PGSQL_dbname'='radicore' (I have created the 'menu', 'workflow', etc. databases. But I do have an system odbc data source named 'radicore'.

Any recommendations?
