$this->sql_select    = 'role_id';
$this->sql_from      = 'mnu_role';
$where = "role_id_snr='".$role_id.'"";
$children_rowdata = $this->_dml_getData($where);
```

Assuming if two rows were returned.

```
"TESTING"
```

```
"TESTING2"
```

I refer to array returned explicitly

```
$children_rowdata[0]['role_id'] //value is "TESTING"
```

```
$children_rowdata[1]['role_id'] //value is "" should be "TESTING2" correct?
```
