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The fieldnames that appear in the errors from the validation-class aren't translated at the moment. You get the name of the databasefield.

For example a dutch user will get an english name in the error and that can be confusing.

I changed the validation class in a few places in this way:

\$translated\_fieldname=getLanguageText(\$fieldname); \$this->errors[\$fieldname] = getLanguageText('sys0021', \$translated\_fieldname, \$size);

Now I can put the translations of the fieldnames in the language file and the problem is solved.

Maybe something to integrate in the next release? Or is there a better solution?
