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That is by design. The UPD1 pattern is part of the group which is automatically created with the LIST1 and LIST2 patterns.

The transaction generation mechanism within Radicore is not the only way to create new transactions. There is nothing to stop you creating new transactions the old fashioned way - by hand. This is what I did for several years before I built the generation mechanism. You can simply copy an existing UPD1 script and make a new one. There is even the copy/paste functionality built into the MNU\_TASK maintenance screens, so it should be no big deal.

If you try it you will find that it takes less time than posting a bug report.
