I have a LIST2 screen which has a nav button to call ADD4 on another table with the multiple selections from the LIST2 screen.

I then wanted to look up the selected records and use some of that data to make the new records.

if 2 lines are selected on the LIST2 screen, ADD4 gets \$where = "( primaryfieldname='X' ) OR ( primaryfieldname='Y' )".

When where 2 array parses it in getInitial Data Multiple() it messes up.

I realize I can do something in \_cm\_initialize to grab it first but it would sure be nice if passing the above \$where to where2array(\$where) would create:
array( primaryfieldname => array(X,Y) )

and then calling array2where() would put it to: "primaryfieldname IN ('X','Y')"

if not, it would at least be good if some form of an array got through to \_cm\_getInitialDataMultiple(\$fieldarray).

Let me know if I am missing some other obvious solution. I am using 1.28.0
