If I do not specify the database name then someone complains, but if I put it in then someone else complains. Some people execute the script without specifying a particular database name because they assume that the script will automatically switch to the correct database, and then complain that it doesn't work.

As it is not possible to know for certain if you are using a prefix with your database names, so the safest option is to leave out the "USE 'xxx';" statement completely. This will mean that everybody will be responsible for identifying the correct database name before executing each script.
