Visit [Home](#)» [PROTO](#)» [Example System](#)» [Tree Type](#)» [Tree Level](#)» [Tree Node](#)» [Child Nodes](#)» [Link Children](#)» [Choose](#) and you will be inside a task entitled 'Choose Orphan Nodes'. This selects all nodes which currently do not have a parent (ie: parent_id is NULL).
