I defined this calculated field in a relationship:

```
CONCAT_WS(',',participante.catsalut, participante.nombre,  
participante.apellido1,participante.apellido2) AS part_det
```

when I saved it it was automatically transformed to:

```
CONCAT_WS('\',\',participante.catsalut, participante.nombre,  
participante.apellido1,participante.apellido2) AS part_det
```

So when running the application I got this error:
