Not managing to get this to work yet. Following your advice I tried creating an upd3 task called 'Print Letter' (used upd3 as this was an available task and gives a SUBMIT button that I thought I could use to execute the print. I set my document\_type popup screen as an initial passthrough task.

In practise when I click the 'Print Letter' task button the popup screen is successfully being displayed, and when I select an option and press CHOOSE I am then returned to the UPD3 screen as expected. However, the popupReturn method does not get executed, so I cannot process the results in the way I want.

Following through with a debugger, I see in std.update3.inc line 66 that \$return\_from contains the name of the popup I am returning from, but \$popup\_object is NULL, so popupReturn does not get executed.

How is \$popup\_object determined?
