I believe the problem is caused by different field names in the parent and child tables. The where string passed down is "location\_id = '55'", into \_sqlAssembleWhere and filterWhere. However, the correct column in the inner table is FKlocation\_id, and the field name location\_id is valid only for the outer table. The function fails to qualify location\_id with the table name, and then deletes the location\_id as that field is not in the table.

This difficulty is not found if the same field name is used in both tables.

I have not stepped through to understand why it works correctly on the second record of the outer table, but trust these details are enough to allow you to reproduce and solve this problem.
