The error message displayed is: Fatal Error: MySQL error: 1052 - Column 'rdcaccount\_id' in where clause is ambiguous (# 1052).

It's because I am joining to a 2nd table, and both tables contain rdcaccount\_id, but the generated SQL has " AND rdcaccount\_id in ('1', 'n') " as part of the WHERE clause. It would need to have " AND table\_name.rdcaccount\_id IN.."

Let me know if you need further info on how I have actually set up the \$where clause, although the rdcaccount\_id reference is being automatically added to the where clause by the framework. I can't see how I can change it.
