I've tried running through my debugger to see why I'm not getting today's messages listed, and I think I may have found a bug - please correct me if I'm wrong...

Lines 315 and 316 in std.table.class.inc show:

```
$search[$start_date] = "<='&date 00:00:00";  
$search[$end_date]   = ">='&date 23:59:59";
```

If I'm not mistaken the times on these two rows should be reversed, to become:

```
$search[$start_date] = "<='&date 23:59:59";  
$search[$end_date]   = ">='&date 00:00:00";
```

The start and end date fields in the mnu\_motd table are defined as date fields rather than datetime fields, so I'm not sure why the times may be having an effect - maybe it's to do with different implementations of MySQL.

Regarding point 2 - this isn't something I need at the moment, but thought it might be a useful addition.
