This is what `$this->_ddl_showDatabases($dbprefix)`

```
Array ( [0] => dev1_audit  
       [1] => dev1_customer  
       [2] => dev1_dict  
       [3] => dev1_menu  
       [4] => dev1_workflow )
```

`$dbnames` contains:

```
Array ( [customer] => customer )
```

See no issue there.

Drilling down into `dict_table_s01` the `_cm_getInitialDataMultiple` function ultimately calls `$this->_ddl_showTables`. Inside the MySQL, MySQLi, and PgSql versions the function grabs the `dbprefix` from `$GLOBALS`. Looking at the Oracle versions there is no reference to the `dbprefix` in the file.

Are you using the Oracle version and hence the reason things work for you and not me? I don't have oracle installed anywhere to test this out.

I know the `dbprefix` gets appended in `dict_table_s01` as well in the mysql calls to `_ddl_showTables`. Hence the doubling up of `dbprefix`.
