This is what \$this->_ddl_showDatabases(\$dbprefix)

\$dbnames contains:

See no issue there.

Drilling down into dict_table_s01 the _cm_getInitialDataMultiple function ultimately calls \$this->_ddl_showTables. Inside the MySQL, MySQLi, and PgSql versions the function grabs the dbprefix from \$GLOBALS. Looking at the Oracle versions there is no reference to the dbprefix in the file.

Are you using the Oracle version and hence the reason things work for you and not me? I don't have oracle installed anywhere to test this out.

I know the dbprefix gets appended in dict_table_s01 as well in the mysql calls to _ddl_showTables. Hence the doubling up of dbprefix.
