Did you restart Apache after commenting out that extension in your php.ini file? What value are you getting from `extension_loaded()` ? If returns TRUE then Radicore will assume that the whole extension has been loaded and that you want to use it. If it later fails because it cannot find `mysqli_real_escape_string()` then it points to a problem with your PHP installation. I have heard of similar problems with these all-in-one packages like WAMP before, which is why I never use them.
