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I have tried following the example shown in the FAQ on how to create an HTML link within each row in a list.

The code I currently have is as follows:

function _cm_formatData ($rowdata, &$css_array)
// perform custom formatting before values are shown to the user.
{
  if (!isset($rowdata['person_name'])) {
    // merge rank first_name and last_name into person_name
    if (isset($rowdata['firstname']) AND isset($rowdata['lastname'])) {
      $rowdata['person_name'] = $rowdata['rank'] . " " . $rowdata['firstname'] . ' ' .
$rowdata['lastname'];
      $rowdata['hyperlnk'] .= 'http://www.bdnw.org.uk';
    } // if
  } // if

  return $rowdata;
} // _cm_formatData
```

The name concatenation works fine, but the url simply appears as [url=www.bdnw.org.uk]in the output screen - not a clickable thing in sight!
