The number of columns in a primary or foreign key should be irrelevant.

You said in your original post that you inserted the code in the `_getData()` function, but this should not be necessary. The primary key of the parent table is automatically passed down to the child table so that it can retrieve only those records which belong to the parent record. The framework knows from the table's structure if the column 'rdccount_id' exists or not, and so deals with it automatically.
