When you supply a user\_id to RADICORE it treats it as a string so will always enclose any value in quotes, thus allowing any combination of numeric and non-numeric characters. Are you trying to access RADICORE's tables through this rival framework, or does this rival framework have its own set of tables where the user\_id is an integer and you are trying to link the two tables?

If you wish to use a pure integer value to link a RADICORE user to an external system there is a field called PARTY\_ID which I added to the MNU\_USER table years ago. I did this to link a user to my version of Len Silverston's PARTY database where party\_id is an auto incrementing integer.
