Hello,

I installed a fresh instance of RADICORE.

I tried to login with user\_id='demo', password='demo', it is not working. I've got "Security violation."

I also tried to login with user\_id='MGR' and password='password', this is not working. I've got "Security violation."

When I try to recover my password, going to:

I receive the following error:

What I am doing wrong?

I tried to digg into the code, somewhere in mnu\_task::checkSelection (\$task\_id)

at line:

```
$fieldarray = $this->getData_raw("mnu_task.task_id=" . addslashes($task_id) . "");  
if ($this->numrows <> 1) {
```

Here \$this->numrows is 0

I did not had time to debug the SQL statements, but there is something wrong.
