The convention here is that all primary keys are named 'id' (1 pk per table) and all foreign keys are named <tablename>\_id.

Unless I'm missing something this convention looks to create a lot of extra work for me. In particular in the list2 transactions.

e.g. if I have the following tables: group, group\_employee, and employee where group\_employee is the link table between group and employee. when I want to do a list2 employees of a particular group I have to modify the where clause in the \_cm\_pre\_getData function and change 'id' to 'group\_id'. Then it doesn't look like I can display groups of a particular employee because how do I know to change 'id' to 'employee\_id' or 'group\_id'?

So, My question: Is this convention going to cause me too many problems or did I miss something?
