You do not need to make any changes to the \$fieldspec array in _cm_changeConfig unless you want the data validated before a WRITE operation, or formatted for display.

You need to check that the new column is actually included in the data which is returned from the call to _dml_getData and added to the XML document. If you look at <http://www.tonymarston.net/php-mysql/infrastructure-faq.html> #faq51 you will see some debugging options that may be useful.
