I created a new table with the following specifications:

```
$fieldspec['id'] = array('type' => 'integer', 'type_native' => 'int', 'size' => 10, 'minvalue' =>
-2147483648, 'maxvalue' => 2147483647, 'pkey' => 'y', 'required' => 'y');
$fieldspec['test_datum'] = array('type' => 'date', 'size' => 12);
```

$this->primary_key = array('id');

When I insert a new record with my application, the line 1.631 in `dml.mysql.class.inc`: `$result = mysqli_query($this->dbconnect, $this->query);` is responsible for inserting the record in my database with the right id and the value 0000-00-00 in the field 'test_datum', if I leave this empty in my screen. I examined the database table before and after executing this line. Before, the record wasn't visible/inserted, afterwards it was.

These variables shows my debugger before executing the line:

Where else can I search for the problem? My debugger doesn't show any further information. I only can see the inserted record in the database table.
