That eregi() error is being generated from your copy of the config.inc file. This must be a very old copy as all ereg* functions were replaced in version 1.54.0 as far back as December 2009.

For not being able to launch project folder in wamp localhost page, it was due to \$suppress_localhost in index.php in www folder that must be set to false.

Though, in the Radicore installation page, point 4 : "You will need to change permissions so that the following directories have write access:"
