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When I use a popup for a field in the outer table of a MULTI4, the outer table's popcall() function does not get called but the inner tables popcall() function gets called instead.

I made a small change to childForm() to get me by. I added \$found_x = true; to the conditional where _x\$ is being stripped off. Then added this code after the 'popup|filepicker' has been determined:

```
if (($pattern_id == 'MULTI4') AND ($found_x)) {  
    reset($object_array);  
    $objectname = key($object_array);  
    $dbobject = $object_array[$objectname];  
}
```

I'm sure you will have a better way, but I thought I should let you know about the issue.

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Here is the fix which I have just tested. Within function childForm() in file include.session.inc change

```
if (is_array($value)) {  
    $offset = key($value);  
} else {  
    $offset = 1;  
} // if  
to  
  
if (is_array($value)) {  
    $offset = key($value);  
} else {  
    $offset = 1;  
    if (count($object_array) > 1) {  
        // set to previous entry in array  
        $null = prev($object_array);  
        $objectname = key($object_array);  
        $dbobject = $object_array[$objectname];  
    } // if  
} // if
```

Let me know if this works for you and I shall include it in the next release.
