There is a setting called \$GLOBALS['XSLT\_client\_side'] in the CONFIG.INC file which can be used for all sessions.

Alternatively you can append the argument 'csxslt=on' or 'csxslt=off' to any query string to switch it either ON or OFF, even in the middle of a session.
