I am trying to update a record and skip the associated validation as per the documentation. However, I've found that `_cm_post_updateRecord()` is being executed on line 4598 of `std.table.class.inc` even though `$this->skip_validation` is set.

Is this a bug or have I misunderstood the processing somewhere?

Unfortunately the documentation is slightly out of date as a call to `_cm_post_updateRecord()` will still be made. This is because I came across a set of circumstances where I wanted to skip the validation but NOT the post-update processing.

If you want the code inside `_cm_post_updateRecord()` to be ignored then you will have to test the contents of `$this->skip_validation` yourself.
