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That file is a copy of dict/sql/mysql/dict-data.sql which uses REPLACE instead of INSERT. Apart from the fact that it allows the script to be run more than once without error, it also caters for the fact that where a record has two foreign keys it is specified once for each foreign key.

I get round any problem by loading the script with pgAdminIII and the 'Execute pgscrip' function instead of the 'Execute query' function. This issues a warning with each duplicate key, not an error.
