How would you go about creating an "on the fly" search to filter out data from a LIST1 screen to a LIST2 screen? The search you currently have works great, but what if you'd like to search within a range of integer field values or dates, rather than only a specific value.

Also, is there any way you can think of implementing a saved search function that would allow for a way to change the sql\_where of a list screen based on values in another table?
